

Women startups find it more difficult to embark on setting up a business, particularly due to greater caution. They have a different measure of risk than men, who can sometimes start a business without thinking too much. Women generally go further in analysing things, they are more perfectionist. That is good, but it can also have the effect of stopping them in their tracks. The aim of entrepreneurs is to try to remove these obstacles, these fears, without, however, hiding the risks inherent in starting out as an entrepreneur. Sometimes they need a structure to say: 'It is possible'.
